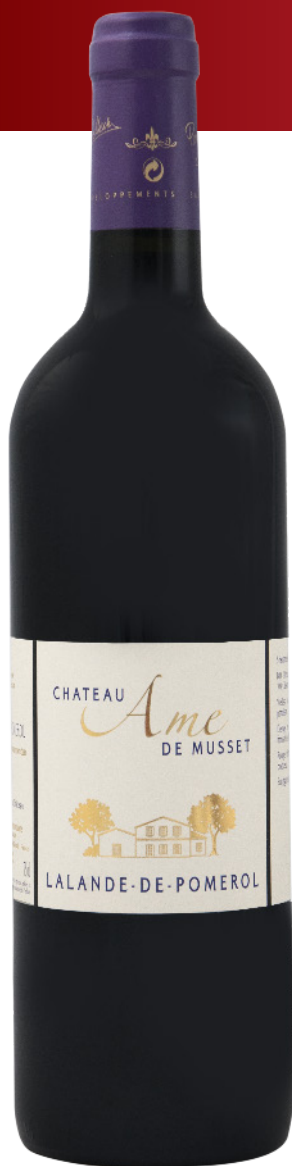


CHATEAU AME DE MUSSET

Lalande-de-Pomerol



PRESENTATION

Chateau Ame de Musset is situated on the commune of Lalande de Pomerol, in the heart of the appellation. This wine area goes back to the time of the knights of the order of Malta and the knights of Saint John Jerusalem who created refuge and hospice on the way to Santiago Compostela.

This old estate is now managed by Pascal DELBECK, renowned Bordeaux winemaker (before owner of Château Belair at Saint-Emilion), his daughter Amandine and his newpew Cédric Berger.

We try to reveal the soul of this terroir named Musset by vinifying close to the expression of This place and this gravelly soil.

TASTING

Vivid red with purple hints, powerful and silky on the palate. To pair with Gigot and spicy food. Perfect for every table moments.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Owner : Les Vignobles Delbeck.

Vineyard : 5 hectares.

Location : Lalande-de-Pomerol.

Grape varieties:

80% Merlot,
10% Cabernet Franc,
10% Cabernet Sauvignon

Harvest : at optimum maturity

Density of planting : 6,000 vines / hectare.

Average age of the vines : 30 years.

Winemaking: Small concrete and stainless steel vats.

Ageing: in french oak barrels for 15 months (40% New and 40% in 1 wine barrel and 20% in vats.
