

CHÂTEAU DE CAMPARIAN Pessac-Léognan Blanc



PRESENTATION

Owned by the Ballande family for 200 years, this vineyard is one of the last to remain in the commune of Villenave d'Ornon, which is less than 7 kilometres from Bordeaux.

The property is in the first 'geographical circle' of the Pessac-Léognan appellation, which is also home to Haut-Brion and Pape Clément.

TASTING

Beautiful bright pale yellow colour. The bouquet is marked by nice floral notes mixed with toasted hints. The attack is frank and fresh.

The midpalate is well-balanced. The finish confirms this lively and aromatic balance.
