

CHATEAU FONGABAN

Côtes de Castillon



PRESENTATION

A few kilometres away from Saint Emilion is located Château Fongaban whose origins date from the 17th century.

The terroir is typical of the two great "Puisseguin Saint Emilion" and "Côtes de Castillon" Appellations d'Origine Contrôlées, both situated in the commune of Puisseguin where are implanted 40 hectares of grape varieties (Merlot and Cabernet Franc), on a clayey and chalky soil totally adapted to vine culture.

TASTING

Château Fongaban offers rich aromas such as black cherry jam, fresh cassis, notes of incense, flowers, spices ... Combining freshness and finesse, maturity and concentration, it is a real treat!

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Surface of the vineyard : 32 ha.

Location : Côtes de Castillon.

Grape varieties : 90% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc.

Average age of the vineyard : 20 years

Harvest : mechanical

Vinification : total de-stemming - light crushing - stainless steel and concrete tanks equipped of thermal and individual regulation (28°C max) - micro-oxygenation under marc - malolactic fermentation in tank.

Maturation : done in an air conditioned winery with hygrometry control. French oak (30% one wine, 30% two wines and 40% in tank with micro-oxygenation).
